Welcome to our first newsletter of the new year!


Each week, Miss Smith will upload our 'Nursery Newsletter' to let you know what we got up to during our time at nursery and any important announcements.

Next week, we will be focussing on our Senses with lots more exciting activities.




Each week there will be a Star of the Week where they get to take our Special Bag and teddy home for the weekend.
