Aragon Primary School Curriculum Map

Year 6

English

We will be studying a range of genres and creating pieces of writing based on the following stimuli:

Alma - Suspense Writing

Once - Diary Writing

The Piano - Fiction Writing

Maths

Describe positions on the full coordinate grid (all four quadrants). Draw and translate simple shapes on the coordinate plane, and reflect them in the axes.

Calculate and interpret the mean as an average. Interpret and construct pie charts and use these to solve problems. Interpret and construct line graphs and use these to solve problems. Convert between miles and kilometres.

Use negative numbers in context, and calculate intervals across zero. Solve Reading number and practical problems that involve negative numbers.

Reading

Whole Class Reading lessons focusing on comprehension and the skills of vocabulary, inference, prediction, explain, retrieve and summarise, using high-quality texts.

Computing: Data and Information

This unit introduces the learners to spreadsheets. They will be supported in organising data into columns and rows to create their own data set. Learners will be taught the importance of formatting data to support calculations, while also being introduced to formulas and will begin to understand how they can be used to produce calculated data. Learners will be taught how to apply formulas that include a range of cells, and apply formulas to multiple cells by duplicating them. Learners will use spreadsheets to plan an event and answer questions. Finally, learners will create charts, and evaluate their results in comparison to questions asked.

Art - Cityscapes

Year 6 will be exposed to cities around the world and how their skylines are recreated using art. The children will learn new art techniques and will discover ways to combine these techniques to create their own original pieces of art work.
