Computing: Programming

This unit develops learners' understanding of instructions in sequences and the use of logical reasoning to predict outcomes.

Learners will use given commands in different orders to investigate how the order affects the outcome. They will also learn about design in programming. They will develop artwork and test it for use in a program. They will design algorithms and then test those algorithms as programs and debug them.

Maths

Recognise, find, name and write fractions 1/3, 1/4, 2/4 and 3/4 of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity. Recognise the equivalence of 2/4 and 1/2. Recognise and show, using diagrams, equivalent fractions with small denominators.

Tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times. Compare and sequence intervals of time. Know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.

Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure capacity (litres/millilitres) to the nearest appropriate unit, using measuring vessels. Compare and order volume/capacity and record the results using >,
