Year I

English

We will be studying a range of genres and creating pieces of writing based on the following stimuli:

The Longest Journey (Descriptive writing)

Pattern and Rhyme (Rhyming Poetry)

The Naughty Bus (Narrative)

Maths

Describe position, direction and movement. Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number. Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and in words. Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations, including a number line. Use the language: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least. Given a number, identify one more and one less. Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (–) and equals (=) signs. Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line.Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20. Add and subtract 1- and 2-digit numbers to 20, including zero. Solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems.

DT: Moving Pictures

Year I will be designing, decorating and building a windmill for their mouse client to live in, developing an understanding of different types of windmill, how they work and their key features.

RE: What gifts might Christians in my town have given Jesus if he had been born here rather than in Bethlehem?

I can talk about a gift that is special to me. I can remember some of the Christmas story. I can suggest a gift I would give to Jesus.

Explore the world of digital art! Year I will create their own paintings, while getting inspiration from a range of other artists. They will consider their preferences when painting with, and without, the use of digital devices.
