Reading - Securing our phonics phase

5. We will be focusing on developing our fluency when reading and our comprehension skills.

History: Kings and Queens

What is a monarch?

Why is King William I known as 'William the Conqueror'?

Why is King John I known as 'Bad King John'?

Who was more powerful - King Henry VIII or Queen Elizabeth I?

How did the Stuarts battle for power?

How did the Hanoverians and Windsors share power with the government?

DT Structures: Baby bear's chair

Using the tale of Goldilocks and the Three Bears as inspiration, children help Baby Bear by making him a brand new chair. When designing the chair, they consider his needs and what he likes and explore ways of building it so that it is strong.

PE - Gymnastics and Games

Maths

Calculate mathematical statements for division within the multiplication tables, and write them using the division (\div) and equals ($=$) signs. Solve problems involving division using materials, arrays, repeated addition, mental methods and division facts, including problems in contexts. Recall and use division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.

Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm) to the nearest appropriate unit using rulers. Compare and order lengths and record the results using $>$, $<$ and $=$. Use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction. Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure mass (kg and g) to the nearest appropriate unit using scales. Compare and order mass and record the results using $>$, $<$ and $=$.

Music: Christmas Performance

We will learn to use our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs. We will play tuned and untuned instruments musically.

Science Uses of Everyday Materials

To identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses

To find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.
