### **Aragon Pupil Reading Survey**

Thank you to all the children who completed the Aragon Reading Survey on Seesaw. We were overwhelmed by the children's positive response to reading. Some of the highlights include:

- 312 KS2 Responses and 68 KS1 responses
- 83% KS2 children and 97% KS2 children enjoy reading
- 95% KS2 children and 100% KS1 children think they are good readers
- 88% KS2 children enjoy the Whole Class Reading sessions in school

### **A selection of what our children like about whole class reading:**

That the teacher sometimes picks you to read.

They are fun lessons that you get to answer questions about books.

People reading the book because it makes me relax.

What I like most about whole class reading are the books that we read because they are fun.

I enjoy reading every day because I'm excited to know what happens next in the story.

Listening to the teacher read.

Reading new books and trying new styles of books like non-fiction books and poetry.
