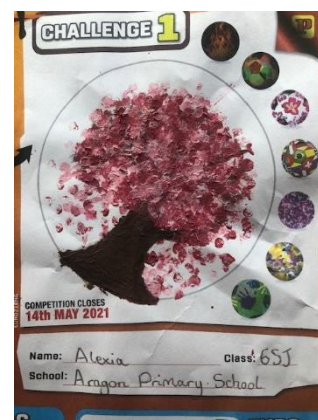
Camera Update
